Manor ISD covers 168 square miles and enrolls 3,300 students for 177 school days a year.

PROPANE COST SAVINGS

We pay \$1.78 per gallon for propane and \$3.18 per gallon for diesel. The new buses average 4 mpg, compared to the diesel buses at 6 mpg.

David Anderson, Chief Financial Officer (512-278-4020), reports Manor ISD has claimed \$4,153 through the federal Motor Fuel Tax Credit, in addition to the savings on the cost of propane.
