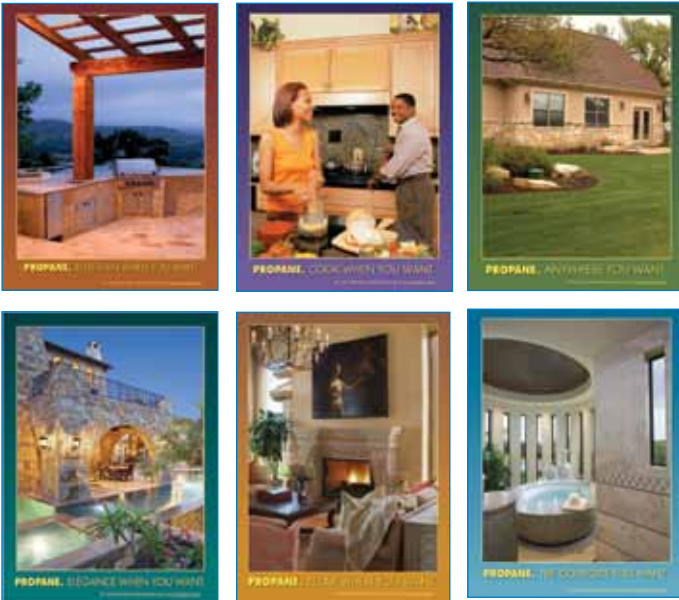

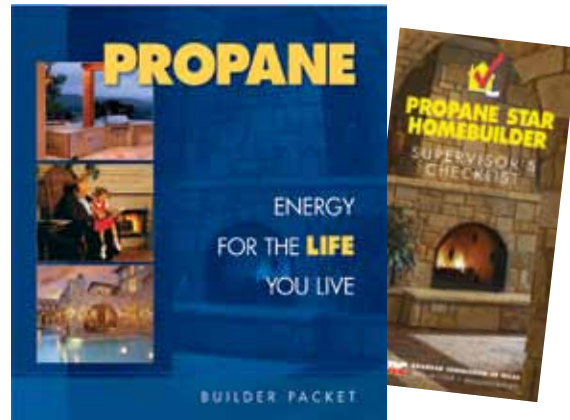

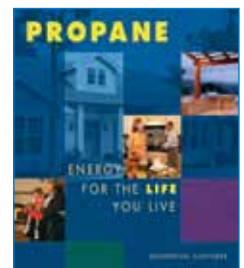

This notebook contains the following safety meeting topics: Interruptions of Service, Gas Leaks, Inspection of DOT Cylinders, Portable Fire Extinguishers, Changing and Filling Forklift Cylinders, Purging of DOT Cylinders, Off-Truck Remote Shutoff, and Requalifying LP-Gas Cylinders.

The Railroad Commission requires all propane gas companies to perform a leak test when refilling an empty tank, to ensure the integrity of your propane piping system. Your propane supplier may have to charge for this service, so you'll save time and money by paying your amount on automatic bill.

The regulator controls the propane gas flow to the burner. If the regulator is not working properly, it can cause a gas leak or fire. Contact a licensed propane technician to inspect and replace the regulator if necessary.
